Comments on Regulation, if any:



- In 2009 and 2010 some amendments were introduced to adapt regulation to EU Directive 26/2005 on Professional Qualifications Recognition. Nevertheless, to date, exact criteria and requirements have not been yet defined.
- In Dec. 2009, Spain introduced some amendments on several laws, to adapt to EU Directive on Services. The omnibus/umbrella law introduced some treats to the continuity of the local Professional Councils or, at least, to the mandatory membership of PIs. By the ending 2010 a new law should clarify this matter. Nevertheless, the umbrella criteria points that membership of PDs to local Councils will be on a voluntary basis.
